Our squad of 17 Competitors; 2 Referees and 1 Table Official.

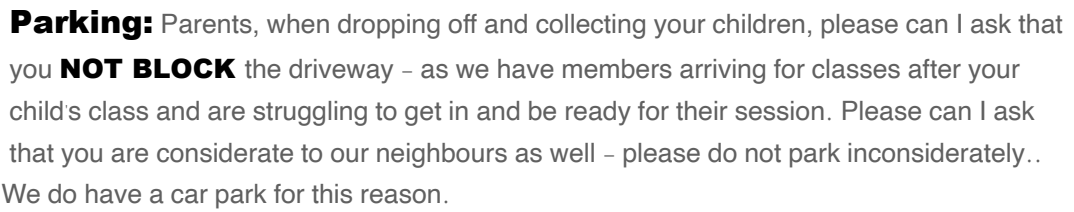
We wish all of our Competitors the best of luck!!
